



Recreational Bathing Facility Sign Requirements

The following information is required on all pools.

Unless otherwise stated one (1) inch bold face, sans serif type is strongly recommended.

Wording in all caps is required by code. Wording in italics is for informational purposes and is not required to be on the sign.
R392-302-22.5, 29.6a-c, 30.a-f

- **WARNING - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY** (*4 inch lettering is required*)
- **BATHERS SHOULD NOT SWIM ALONE** (*4 inch lettering is required*)
- **CHILDREN 14 AND UNDER SHOULD NOT USE POOL WITHOUT RESPONSIBLE ADULT SUPERVISION** (*2 inch lettering is recommended*)
- **In Case Of Emergency Dial 911** (*or list Emergency services contact numbers*)
 - The nearest telephone is located: (*Post location of the nearest telephone*)
- **Take a Cleansing Shower Before Entering Pool.**
 - After using the toilette take a cleansing shower before returning to the pool
- **Anyone Having a Communicable Disease Transmissible by Water, Or Having Any Open Blisters, Cuts, or Other Lesions May Not Use The Pool.**
- **Anyone Who Has Had Diarrhea Within The Last Two Weeks May Not Enter The Pool.**
- **Children Under the Age of 3, Children Not Toilet Trained, and Anyone Who Lacks Control of Defecation Must Wear a Swim Diaper and Waterproof Swimwear With Fitted Waist and Leg Openings.**
- **Change Diapers Only In Restrooms or at Approved Changing Stations. Do Not Change Diapers Poolside**
- **Running, boisterous play, or rough play, except supervised water sports, are prohibited**

The following information is required only if a spa pool is present. Wording in all caps is required by code. R392-302-31.2s (i-x)

- **CAUTION** (*2 inch lettering is required*)
- **Elderly persons and those suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure should consult a physician before using the spa pool.**
- **Persons suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water may not use the spa pool. Persons using prescription medications should consult a physician before using the spa.**
- **Individuals under the influence of alcohol or other impairing chemical substances should not use the spa pool.**
- **Bathers should not use the spa pool alone.**
- **Pregnant women should not use the spa pool without consulting their physicians.**
- **Persons should not spend more than 15 minutes in the spa in any one session.**
- **Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied and supervised by at least one responsible adult over the age of 18 years, when lifeguards are not on duty.**
- **Children under the age of five years are prohibited from bathing in a spa or hot tub.**
- **Running or engaging in unsafe activities or horseplay in or around the spa pool is prohibited.**
