
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

General Resources



ICS 214 Booklets - Spiral bound notebook that contains HICS 214 forms for logging emergency response activities; includes instructions for completing the forms as well.



Public Health Emergency Guides - A comprehensive list of what to do before, during and after an emergency, along with other great emergency information.



Chempack - EMS - The container holds nerve agent antidotes and supporting supplies for 454 treatments. St George Regional Medical Center maintains this in a secure and climate controlled storage. Available for request by calling dispatch.



Chempack - Hospital - The container holds nerve agent antidotes and supporting supplies for 1000 treatments. St George Regional Medical Center maintains this in a secure and climate controlled storage. Available for request by calling dispatch.



POD Kit - The POD Kit contains supplies needed for all operations at a Point of Dispensing (POD) site, including ICS vests, job action sheets, clipboards, pens, signage, etc.

Emergency Response Trailers - Large cargo trailers with awnings, onboard generators, lighting, AC/Heat, sink, and fold up tables.



Gorilla Cart - Heavy-duty steel utility cart/wagon with removable sides, 15" tires, 1400 lb capacity.



Trailer Dolly - 600 lb capacity.




Portable Misting Fan - Portable cooling and misting fan, high-velocity, 3 speeds with misting ring; reduce strain on responders and victims during high heat events.




Environmental Emergency Kit - Contains all supplies needed to collect food, water, soil or other environmental samples.



Suspension Containers - Containers for preparing antibiotic suspension; support for response to biological threat.



Sterile Specimen Containers



Radiation Detectors - Light-weight instrument designed for quick and reliable measurement of gamma radiation dose rates.



Flood Mitigation Kits - Grab & Go Flood Kit includes 20- 2ft Water Activated Flood Bags in Bucket. Grows to 3.5in high in minutes, just get them wet. Contains up to 50ft of flood Protection in each Bucket. Use to control, contain & divert flood water.



Water Bag - Disposable 1.5 gallon water bags connect directly to outflow of the 750 gallon-per-hour water filtration system.



Replacement Water Filters - Replacement filters for the 750 gallon-per-hour water filters. Several different types of filters including viral, sediment, and carbon.



Water Filtration System - 750 Gallon-per-hour water filtration system. Includes sediment, carbon, virus media and UV filters.

Small Water Filtration System - 300 gallon-per-hour water filtration system. It is effective against viruses, bacteria, and cysts in fresh water sources. Four-tier Zeonic™ filtration and high power UV disinfection.

Disaster Response Unit - The Disaster Response Unit, also known as The DRU, is a non-mobile trailer housing supplies available for emergency response, including medical/surgical supplies, fans, cots, linens, etc. Located in Cedar City.

Bleeding Control Training Kit - For "Stop the Bleed" classes or active shooter exercises. Includes: 20 CAT tourniquets, 20 combat gauze, 20 Compressed Gauze, 20 Pressure Dressings, 20 chest seals, 20 instructions, 4 medical shears, 2 quick litters, 12 foam sim arms, and one of each recommended CoTCCC tourniquets. Note: 12 sim arms and additional training tourniquets are contained in a clear plastic tote if needed.



Moulage Kit - Moulage kit for dressing victims in exercises. Includes fake blood, makeup sponges, wipes, gloves, and various fake limbs showing different types of injuries.



MED Surge Table top game - Medical surge table-top game; excellent training tool; EMS and hospital versions available.

Blood Pressure Cuff - Adult and child Sizes



Finger Pulse Oximeter - Used to measure the oxygen level of blood.

Includes reinforced windlass, stabilization plate, windlass clip, and writable windlass security strap.



Bleeding Control Kit - Basic Bleeding Control kit with: CAT Tourniquet, Medical Shears, Pressure Bandage, Mini Sharpie, Instructions, Emergency Blanket.



Conforming Stretch Gauze Bandage - Easily molded to body contours; allows for patient flexibility.



Bag Valve Masks - Allows for oxygenation and ventilation of patients until a more definitive airway can be established and in cases where endotracheal intubation or other definitive control of the airway is not possible.



Shelter Resources



Emergency Shelter - Inflatable shelter, 16' wide 20' long 8' tall (interior). Waterproof; can withstand winds up to 20 mph. Requires constant inflation via blower (included).

Air Blower - 1HP Kodiak Blower. Creates 8.8" of static pressure at a 7.0 amp draw. Has a reverse air louver assembly outlet, a 25ft cord. 33 lbs with built-in handle.



Ventilator Fan - Portable 12-inch diameter blower/ventilator fan; two-speed blower; lightweight with easy-carry handle. For use with tents for ventilation; includes a 15-ft flexible vent duct.



Easy-Up Canopy - Various canopy or shade structures; easy to set up.



Sandbag - Nylon sandbag for weighing down tents or easy-up shade structure.



PVC/Concrete Weights - PVC pipe filled with concrete; metal loops on ends allow threading of rope; useful for tying down tents or canopies.



AFN Support Kit - Support kit for use in mass shelters or family assistance centers. Kit contains: pocket translators, infant formula, baby bottles, breast pumps, pacifiers, catheters, ostomy bags, hygiene kits, adult and child diapers, baby wipes, sanitary pads, tampons, tissues, reading glasses, flip flops, ear muffs, ear plugs, blankets, coloring books, Fire Tablet w/ charger, sound amplifiers, USB charge dock, Android and iPhone charging cords.



Mass Care Hygiene Kits - Each personal supply kit includes a blanket and pillow, as well as 1 toothbrush, 1 tube tooth gel, 1 security razor, 1 (2-oz) bath and body gel, 1 (3-oz) deodorant soap and 1 (5-in) comb.



Linen Sets - Each linen set includes 2 sheets, a blanket, and one pillow with a pillowcase.





Wheelchair - Capable of a 450 lbs. weight capacity. Transport for persons unable to walk as a result of illness, injury, or disability.



Disaster Blanket - 70% Wool, 30% Synthetic Fiber. 60 x 80 inches.



Large Grey Privacy Screens - Folding privacy screen; ideal for administering vaccines or other medical procedures.



Bariatric Cot - Cot has steel legs and brackets, aluminum end and side bars, 600D poly canvas cover, storage/carry bag. Dimensions: 85 in. L x 40 in. W x 19 in. H. Weight Capacity: 600 lb.



Cot - Cot rated to 350 lbs, steel frame, water-resistant coated nylon cover. Measures 75 in. L x 25.5 in. W x 16 in. H. Zippered storage pouch for personal items. Nylon carry/storage bag.



Special Needs Cot - Oversize cot for special needs includes side rails, washable mesh mat, 4-position elevation for head and feet, IV pole sleeves at all 4 corners, 2-inch-thick mattress.

Honda 3000 Inverter Generator - 120 volt, 3000 Watt gasoline generator. 3.4 gallon tank. Will run 7.2 hours at full load, 20 hours at ¼ load. 134 lbs.



Generator 10,000 Watt - 10,000 Watt gasoline generator. Starting watts 12,500, volts 120-240, amps 83.3-41.6; 7-gallon tank will run 7.5 hrs at 1/2 load. 437 lbs.



Goal Zero Batteries - Quiet, portable power at the push of a button. 400Wh, 33Ah (12V) Battery capacity. Weight 12.9 and 29 lbs. Numerous powering options including two USB ports, two AC outlets and 12V output.



Inflatable Light Tower - 14' Inflatable light tower. 1,100 Watts, 111,000 lumen output. Includes: receiver hitch mount/dolly, stakes and guy-ropes, 72 lbs.



Inflatable Light Tower - 15' Inflatable Light Tower. Requires 1,000 Watts to operate. Older light with Halide bulb.



Yellow cord cover - Made of hard plastic; reduces safety hazards, prevents tripping and protects cords.



Triage Bag - Black triage duffel bag with triage tarps, triage tags, and triage tape, as well as color-coded vests for each treatment area and incident commander



Hand Washing Stations - Foot-pump hand washing system; extra long tubing and zip ties for attaching to sink faucet; includes 5-gallon water container. Bucket not included.


Portable Crib - Pack-n-play portable crib for infants and small children. Can be used for shelters.



Propane Patio Heater - Propane heater warms a 20 foot diameter, 100% burner shut-off for added safety, stainless steel construction, 37,500 BTU's. Includes propane tank.



Metal Stanchions - Upright metal post; support for managing flow of people at Point of Dispensing (POD) or other emergency event or exercise.



Traffic Cones - Collapsible light-up traffic cones; 5-pack; each requires 2 AAA batteries.



Candlestick Traffic Cones - 42" high

Personal Protective Equipment



Ebola PPE Barrel - Personal protective equipment (PPE) for infectious disease outbreaks such as Ebola. Includes sharps container, shoe covers, gloves, gowns, disposable hood, bodysuits, masks, germicidal wipes, boots, waste bags, waste scale, etc.



ISO-POD Pediatric - Pediatric negative-pressure individual patient isolation and transportation system that keeps contamination and disease inside the unit; protects first responders and allows for life-saving medical procedures.



ISO-POD Choice - Adult-size negative-pressure individual patient isolation and transportation system; keeps contamination and disease inside the unit; protects first responders and allows for life-saving medical procedures.



ISO-POD PPE Bundle - Black duffel with personal protective equipment (PPE) to support ISO-POD units. Includes coverall suits, boot covers, face shields, gloves, masks, gowns, germicidal wipes, and waste bags.




PAPR SET (Honeywell) - One breathing tube, One hood, Five HEPA Filter Cartridges, PAPR Starter Kit w/ HEPA.



PPE Hood - Personal protective equipment (PPE) single-use hood.



Disposable Isolation Gown - Large, XL. Single use only.



Surgical Gown - Sterile, Intended to be used for surgery, Single Use Only.



Isolation Coveralls - Sm, Md, Lg, XI, 2XI, 3XI. Level two protection. Non sterile, impermeable isolation gown with full front covered opening and elastic at face and cuffs. Designed to be worn over clothing. Not for use in a surgical setting or where significant exposure to liquid bodily or other hazardous fluids may be expected. Disposable, single use.



Washable/Reusable Isolation Gown - L/XL. Level 1 Isolation Gown. Not for use in Surgical Setting.



Trainings Offered

Opioid Overdose Education/Narcan Training: Education and training session. Public will gain education around opioids, ability to recognize signs and symptoms of an opioid overdose, how to administer Naloxone (Narcan), Resources regarding Narcan and substance use, and additional alternatives to consider around opioids.

Stop the Bleed: Through our STOP THE BLEED® course, you will gain the ability to recognize life-threatening bleeding and intervene effectively. Take the course and become empowered to make a life or death difference when a bleeding emergency occurs. STOP THE BLEED®. Save a Life!

Closed POD: Closed PODs are sites staffed and managed by organizations and agencies (both public and private) to dispense MCMs to their own populations while continuing operations during a public health emergency. A signed MOU is required for an organization to become a closed POD.

Intro to Emergency Communications: Training on basic emergency communications, creating a family emergency communications plan, emergency alert systems (county, weather, national), types of radios, and basic radio operation.

Mass Casualty Incident Triage: 15 Till 30 MCI Tabletop Exercise for Hospitals and First Responders.

ChemPack: CHEMPACKs are containers of nerve agent antidotes placed in secure locations in local jurisdictions around the country to allow rapid response to a chemical incident. These medications treat the symptoms of nerve agent exposure and can be used even when the actual agent is unknown.

Training focuses on identification, requesting, and utilizing ChemPac resources in the Southwest Region.


Basic Radio Communications: Training on using common radios used by healthcare, first responders, Skilled Nursing Facilities, etc. Includes radio operation, radio etiquette, channel/frequency familiarization, and a practical exercise using radios. Radios for exercise can be provided by SWUPHD.

TCCC: Tactical Combat Casualty Care. This class incorporates tactics with point of injury care. You will learn the 3 phases of TCCC, the MARCH sequence and practice life saving interventions with hands-on training.

PPE Donning & Doffing: Training on how to safely Don and Doff Standard Precaution, Contact Precautions, and Airborne Precaution Personal Protective Equipment.

State Resources

CISM Team - The Utah Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) Program has been established to assist emergency service workers throughout the State. The CISM Team comprises mental health professionals and peer support personnel who are trained to assist emergency responders in dealing with the stress of their profession. A resource request should be made through your Local Health Dept or Regional Coalition Coordinator for preplanned events, pre-Stafford Act emergencies, and during a declared emergency. - To request resources during a pre-Stafford Act emergency: In coordination with the Local Health Department and DHHS, there is a 24hr DHHS Disaster Line at 1-866-8824 and follow up that request with an email to udohdoc@utah.gov.
- During a declared emergency local operation centers should work through their ESF8 personnel to request resources from the State EOC.




